

College Score Card - The College Scorecard is designed to increase transparency, putting the power in the hands of the public — from those choosing colleges to those improving college quality — to see how well different schools are serving their students.

Summary of data:

- (a) Data showed that MBU was at or near the median for colleges in their peer group in the areas of average cost, graduate rates, and salary after attending. This information can be used to review cost of attendance, effectiveness of academic support services, and services offered through the alumni office.
- (b) Data shows that MBU students are above average (75%) in paying down their debt as compared to the national average of 66%.
- (c) MBU graduate rates of 41% is just under the national average of 43%. The first year retention for MBU students of 60% is below the national average of 67%. This information has been used to develop programs to increase these averages through various initiatives. One of these initiatives was to be part of the HLC Academy for Student Persistence and Completion. MBU also identified Persistence and Completion as the Universities Quality Initiative.
