

MoGEA – The Missouri Educator Gateway Assessment (MoGEA) is a test for admission into undergraduate educator preparation programs in Missouri includes sections on English language arts, writing, mathematics, science and social science. The assessment began in September 2013 and replaced the College BASE (CBASE) test.

#### Summary of Data

In 2015 – 2016 the MoGEA test was taken 310 times, with 277 (89.3%) of the students passing on the first attempt. The first attempt pass rate by area was: Mathematics (92.1%), Reading Comprehension & Interpretation (95.8%), Writing (88.0%) and Writing 91.2%).
