GET TO KNOW YOUR DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

The men and women of the MBU Department of Public Safety take great pride in providing a wide range of quality law enforcement services to the faculty, staff, students and visitors in the MBU community.

Emergency Call Buttons - located in each classroom and common area. Public Safety will respond when these buttons are pressed.

Text Services - Opt-in notification system for emergency notifications.

Blue Light Phones - strategically placed throughout campus, the Blue Light Phones are equipped with speakerphones and strobe lights. Use if experiencing car problems, wanting to report suspicious activity or medical emergency.

- •In an emergency off campus, call 911.
- •MBU leased Off Campus Apartments are patrolled by MBU and Creve Coeur Police
- •Never open the door for strangers; use the door peep hole.
- •Keep doors and windows locked, even while at home.
- Never loan your keys.
- •Do not publicly post your full name and address.
- •Avoid walking alone at night; take a friend.
- •If you are uncomfortable walking to your car/dorm, call Public Safety.
- •Report any suspicious activity to Public Safety or local police.

- •Avoid tailgating do not let a suspicious individual follow you into your dorm building; all individuals authorized to enter a dorm building must have a key and proxy; if they do not have a key/proxy, politely tell them they should contact the Office of Resident Life or Public Safety.
- •Never prop doors open, even if only for a few minutes.
- •Always lock your door and keep your valuables out of plain sight.
- •Record all serial and ID numbers for electronics; consider registering electronics with Public Safety.
- •Report broken locks and lost keys to Resident Life for immediate replacement.
- •Never loan your keys.
- •Do not publicly post your full name and address.
