

## Requirements

All undergraduate students on Main Campus are required to complete the CLP. For each semester of full-time enrollment on Main Campus, students are required to earn 15 CLP points. CLP points may be earned from various options, all connected to MBU's Core Values: Faith, Truth, Excellence, Character, and Social Change. At least ten points must be earned through Chapel attendance.

Each student is responsible for selecting CLP options that will meet the requirement. Participation may affect your GPA.

<12 Points = -1 Quality Point

12-15 points = 0

16+ = +1 Quality Point

\*At least 12 points must be earned via Chapel.

\*\*A student who earns less than 10 CLP points will lose 1 quality point and will be in danger of being placed on disciplinary probation. \*\*\*To record participation in the CLP, download and use the iAttended App. Use the App Store links below:
