## MEES School Librarian Candidate Summative Rubric Scoring Protocol

- For any descriptor score of 0 within a standard, the candidate must demonstrate that the standard was met with at least one additional artifact.
- For summative scores of $1-3$ within a standard, the candidate will receive the majority score. For example, if there are two descriptors that falls within level 2, and one descriptor falls within level 3, a score of 2 will be assigned.
- To earn a summative score of 4 within a standard, the candidate must earn all level 3 descriptors plus at least one level 4 descriptor.
- If the descriptor scores are split evenly between two levels, the lower score will be assigned. For example, if there is one descriptor that falls within level 1 and one descriptor falls within level 3 , a score of 1 will be assigned. Additionally, if there are two descriptors that fall within level 2 , and two descriptors that fall within level 3 , a score of 2 will be assigned.
- If the descriptor scores are spread evenly between multiple levels, then the median score will be assigned. For example, if there is one descriptor that falls within level 1 , one descriptor falls within level 2 , and one descriptor falls within level 3 , a score of 2 will be assigned.
- For some standards, a discussion rather than observation may be necessary.
- All standards must be scored on the Summative Evaluation.
