


Steps for Checking your FAFSA Application Status

Log in to the student's account at [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov)

- You will use your FSA ID (Username / Password combination) the student used when completing their 24-25 FAFSA.
- Complete the 2-factor authentication (usually via text message or email to the student)

Navigate to your account Dashboard.

Scroll down to “My Activity”, and click on the 2024-25 FAFSA Form (*example below*):



The application status will be one of the following:

Draft: Your section of the FAFSA form is incomplete.

In Progress: You provided your consent, approval, and signature to your section of the FAFSA form, but the FAFSA form has not been submitted yet.

In Review: You have submitted your form and your application is still processing.

Processed: Your application was processed successfully. No further action is needed.

Action Required: Your application requires further action from you or your contributor(s). In some cases, you may need to contact your college or career/trade school to resolve the issue.

Closed: Your FAFSA form was never submitted and can no longer be submitted because the federal FAFSA deadline passed.

Scroll down to the “Status Tracker” for updates on the FAFSA Processing status and to retrieve your “FAFSA Submission Summary” (*example below*):

FAFSA® Form Started

The student should complete most of the form themselves, including their personal and financial information. You must fill out the section assigned to you. If you can't access the site due to scheduled maintenance, you will be able to log in once the site is available again. The student's data is still in the system and is secure. Once all required sections are complete, everyone must sign and submit.

Steps for Retrieving your Student Aid Index (SAI)

Click on the “FAFSA Submission Summary” box.

At the bottom of the Estimated Federal Student Aid section, you will find your student’s SAI. Providing MBU’s Financial Services team with a copy of your FAFSA Submission Summary OR your Student Aid Index, we may be able to provide estimates of your eligibility ahead of when your FAFSA will be sent to MBU by the federal government.

Estimated Federal Student Aid

Federal Direct Loans
A federal direct loan is money lent by the government to you that you must repay with interest. Up to **\$5,500**

Federal Work-Study
Federal Work-Study is a way for students to earn money to pay for school through part-time jobs on or off campus. **You May Be Eligible**

Amounts shown here are only estimates of federal student aid based on full-time enrollment and the average cost of attendance. Your school will determine how much student aid to offer you, which may include additional aid from your school or state.

Your Student Aid Index (SAI)
Your SAI is a number used by your school to determine your federal student aid eligibility and to build your financial aid offer. Your SAI may change due to verification or if you update or correct your FAFSA information. **13237**
