CLP Overview


We believe that each person needs to be developed holistically in order to love and serve both God and neighbor.

Students will engage in a variety of transformational experiences that promote spiritual, educational, and cultural maturity. The CLP emphasizes the Christian identity and mission of the University, accentuating the University's Core Values.

Requirements

All undergraduate students on Main Campus are obligated to complete the CLP requirements. For each semester of full-time enrollment on Main Campus, students are required to earn a minimum of 12 CLP points. CLP points may be earned from various options, all connected to MBU's Core Values:

Faith, Truth, Excellence, Character, and Social Change.

- Less than 12 Points = -1 Quality Point
- 12-15 points = 0
- 16+ = +1 Quality Point
- At least 10 community life points must be earned via Chapel.
- A student who earns less than 12 CLP points will lose 1 quality point and will be in danger of being placed on disciplinary probation.
